Test Name and Description	Range	Your Results
<b>PSA Value</b> The prostate specific antigen value you had immediately prior to surgery (and hormones, if they were administered prior to surgery)	0 – 100 ng/ml (actually can be higher but our nomograms only allow up to 100)	
<b>Specimen Gleason Sum</b> The Gleason sum from your radical prostatectomy pathology report.	Whole number from 2 to 10	
<b>Surgical Margins</b> Whether or not your surgical margins were positive or negative.	Positive or negative	
<b>Prostatic Capsular Invasion Level</b> The level of your prostatic capsular invasion.	None, invades capsule, focal, established	
<b>Seminal Vesicle Involvement</b> Whether or not your seminal vesicles were involved.	Yes or no	
<b>Lymph Node Involvement</b> Whether or not your lymph nodes were involved (if any were removed in a pelvic lymph node dissection).	Yes or no
